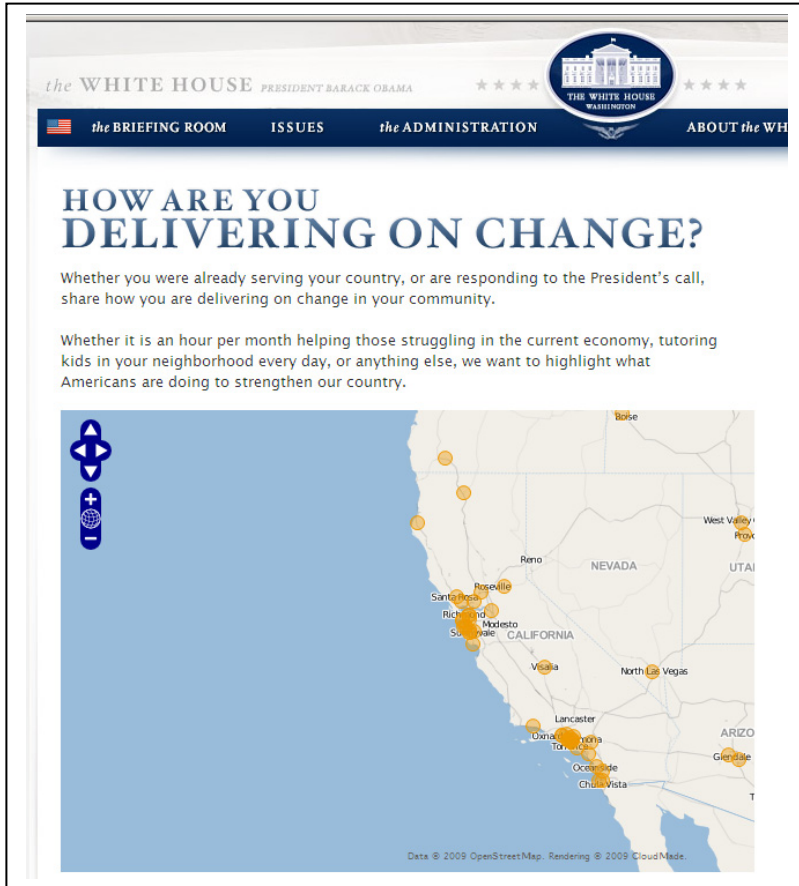


# Let the President know ... Service-Learning is Delivering on Change
